School Uniform Code

Rationale

Monash Primary and Preschool promotes a school identity through a set of guidelines for student dress based on school colours. The wearing of School uniform is an important safety factor in that we can clearly recognise student's association with our school. Clothing should be worn which allows freedom of movement and a level of comfort. At all times the shoulders must be covered.

When representing the school, students will be expected to wear school colours, including a polo shirt with the school logo.

Clothing items which fit our School Uniform Policy:

- Polo shirt or Sports shirt – essential uniform
- School jumper/rugby top/fleece jacket – essential uniform
- Maroon bucket hat – essential uniform
- Shorts/Skirts/Long pants/track pants/parachute pants –black or grey
- A line summer dress
- Winter skirt
- Suitable footwear for active play

Brand names is to be avoided or minimised to maintain the integrity of the School Uniform Code.

Clothing which is unsuitable for school wear:

- Shoes: thongs, bare feet, crocs, Ugg boots, strapless sandals, high heeled shoes
- Clothing: very brief or short shorts/skirts/dresses, strapless and halter tops, shoestring straps, clothing with offensive messages
- Piercings: Facial piercings, hooped or large earrings

Preschool Children

Children in the preschool can wear a school polo shirt which comes in a range of colours, this will be organised at transition visits.

Monitoring, Evaluation and Review

This policy has been reaffirmed by the Governing Council and is subject for review every 5 years or when required.
